The Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, is in receipt of information that a good number of students took admission at the Undergraduate courses in more than one college and/or more than one subject, blocking many seats unnecessarily. As a result, many students are deprived of getting admitted in colleges for want of vacancies. Now it is felt necessary, that the respective universities may issue notification for its affiliated colleges, so that college authority may collect declaration from their admitted students regarding their admission status in more than one colleges and the choice of any one college surrendering the other seats for the purpose of registration by the university within seven days from the date of notification by the college authority, failing which, the registration of the studentship will be denied / cancelled by the university authority as and when it is detected.
