Sanskrit texts are available for numerous sciences like astronomy, aeronautics, dietetics, architecture, chemistry, pharmacology etc. in which intensive and extensive researches are required. The language was originally a medium of ancient Indian texts, and was important to the development of Indian philosophy, religion, art, science, and literature. Dr Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India, opined, "Our culture, literature and life are incomplete as long as our scholars, thinkers and educators are ignorant of Sanskrit."

Sanskriti symbolizes the cultural heritage and lifestyle of the Indian subcontinent. Indian culture embodies diversity, tradition, religion, language, art, and various aspects of life. It is an example of historical and physical development and has been one of the leading forces of Indian society.

Bharatvarsha is the ancient name of India and encompasses all its languages, cultures, and communities. It represents the Indian subcontinent morphologically and physically and describes the extent of its land. India is a land rich in religious and cultural heritage, with followers of Hinduism, Jainism, Buddhism, Sikhism, Islam, and other religions.
