- **Full paper within 3000 words** along with an **abstract (between 250-300 words)**, in Times New Roman 12pt size font, with margin of 1.5" on all sides, Microsoft Word format should be submitted by **1st December 2022**.
- All the authors must be registered for the seminar. In the case of co-authored papers, at least one author has to be present during the seminar to present the paper.

- Of the papers presented in the seminar only the accepted once will be published in the Post Seminar volume with **ISBN**.
