6. Use of Institutional Infrastructure:

Allowing mutual access to certain facilities, such as libraries, labs, and learning spaces as per availability and approval.

7. Joint NSS Activities

Organising collaborative NSS activities like awareness programme, tree plantation etc

8. Rural developmental Work

Through Unnat Bharat Abhiyan we can jointly conduct some initiative work for rural development process.
